Changes to school rules for Autumn term 2020

These additions to the school rules are designed to keep the school community safe and to ensure that everyone adheres to the social-distancing measures during the Covid-19 outbreak. They will be reviewed as government guidance is updated.

- Children and staff will be expected to follow social distancing measures in school, where possible. This will include regular handwashing, and staying 2 metres apart from others where this is possible, or 1 metre plus in areas where 2 metres is not possible. Some areas of the school will be marked out to show 2 metre social distancing where possible, or 1 metre plus in other areas - children should adhere to this eg when queueing to come into the building, go to the toilet etc.
- Each child (y1-y6) will have a set place to sit in, beside a partner and facing the front. The pair will share resources. It is their responsibility to look after these resources. They should not touch other children's resources and resources can only be shared with your partner. Children should not swap places with other children.
- EYFS children will have a set carpet place – they should sit only in their carpet place.
- Children should not travel outside of their classroom area without permission of an adult.
- Children should stick to the school's hygiene guidelines.
- Children should not intentionally cough or spit at each other. Children should not tease others about having coronavirus.
- Children are expected to show all adults in school respect.
- Playfighting and physical contact in the playground will not be tolerated.
