### Skills and knowledge

Use sketchbooks to record ideas.

Experiment with showing line, tone and texture with different hardness of Pencils.

### Skills and knowledge

### Skills and knowledge

To be able to set up a simple practical enquiry.

To be able to identify common appliances that run on electricity

To be able to construct a simple series electrical circuit

To be able to identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit

To be able to set up a simple practical enquiry

### Vocabulary

Electricity, appliances: fridge, freezer, TV, computer, iron, kettle, etc Series circuit. Components: battery, bulb (lamp), bulb (lamp) holder, buzzer, crocodile clip, leads, wires, switch. Describing words: brighter, duller, slow, fast, quiet, loud. Conductor, insulator. Effects of electricity: Light, sound, movement, heat. Switches – open, close

### Skills and Knowledge

Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on South America concentrating on environmental regions & key physical & human characteristics.

Identify the position & significance of latitude, longitude, equator, northern hemisphere, southern hemisphere, arctic & Antarctic circle, the prime/Greenwich meridian & time zones.

Use key vocabulary. (see list below)

Use maps, atlases, globes & digital/computer mapping to locate countries & describe features studied.
