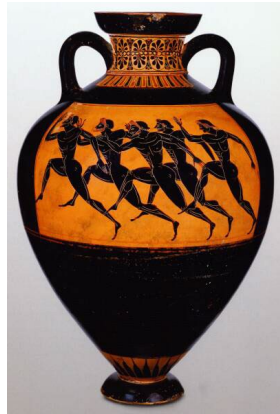


Year 6 – Spring 1
