- **the parts of plants** (identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. By the end of Yr2 at least: flower, leaf, root, stem, trunk, seed, branch and petal)

We are learning to:

- ask questions in science lessons (to be able to ask simple questions and recognise that they can be answered in different ways)
- **observe** (to be able to observe closely using simple equipment)
- **collect information** (to be able to gather and record data to help answer a question)
