Nursery Home Learning Grid

Communication and Language

Develop your child's language through story time. Whilst reading with your child, spark conversation regarding the story, characters and its setting. Questioning your child regarding the text will support them to develop their conversational skills.

Personal Social & Emotional Development

Spend time playing games at home that require turn taking to ensure your child is able to wait their turn.



Physical Development

Support your child's physical development by allowing them to join in with preparing food for meals at home. Using a knife to chop fruit or vegetables will support the development of your child's fine motor skills; this will help them with their pencil control when they learn to write.





Literacy

Support your child to hear the initial sounds in words.

Such as 'C' in cat. In doing so, you will support your child's phonological development which is an important early reading skill.

Understanding the World

This term, our topic is 'All creatures great and small'

We will be looking at the life cycle of a frog. Why not explore other life cycles such as a caterpillar, a broad bean or a duck?

Mathematics

Collect different shaped leaves in the park. Talk about the different patterns, shapes and sizes you see. Perhaps you could order the leaves from smallest to biggest.



Expressive Arts and Design



Gather some kitchen utensils you can use to create different prints whilst painting. You can then explore and create different patterns.
