Show Racism the Red Card is an anti-racism educational charity who work to challenge racism through empowering role models within communities, organisations, and sports, in order to dismantle racism in society.

As a school, we will be raising funds for the charity by joining in with 'Wear it Red' and all wearing red clothes to school. Donations can be made via your ParentPay accounts or loose gold coins brought in to school.

During the school day, children will participate in a class lesson linked to racism that allows opportunities for discussion and reflection. Please be assured each class teacher will ensure the lesson content and discussion is age appropriate. Children as young as three recognise race and racial differences, so you can never start talking about race and racism too early. Talking about racism regularly is the first step towards making a positive social change.

We will also be running our own competition in school as part of 'Wear it Red' day. Every child will be designing their own t-shirt with an anti-racism logo. One design from each year group will be chosen to have their design brought to life and have their t-shirt printed!
