In class

We have Mrs Messett (Mon – Thurs) and Mrs Tahir (Fri) as our Teaching Assistants and 1:1 support this term. In addition, Miss Diamant will be teaching some lessons on Tuesdays.



Science

Our Topic this term is **Changes around us – seasons.**

We will learn - To be able to ask simple questions and recognise that they can be answered in different ways, to identify objects, to perform simple tests, to observe closely, using simple equipment, to gather and record data to help answer a question, observe changes across the 4 seasons and observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

<u>P.E.</u>

P.E. will take place every **Monday** and **Tuesday** and both sessions will be outdoors. P.E. kit will be worn all day. Please allow children to wear trainers during the cold weather.

PSHE

Our main focus for Spring 2 will be to ensure that all children are happy, healthy and feel safe at school. We will be focussing on feelings and emotions; healthy relationships this term.

RE

We will be learning about the Creation this term. Each week we'll be focussing on different religions and their creation stories.

Geography

Our Geography topic this term is 'Our Local Area'. We will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key human and physical features,

Devise a simple map; & use & construct basic symbols in a key;

Use simple fieldwork & observational skills to study the geography of the surrounding area, including key human & physical features and using a range of methods. There is a possibility of us taking a walk in the local area.

Home Learning

Home Learning will be posted every Thursday on Google Classrooms. Your child will be expected to complete their tasks by the following Tuesday. This includes weekly Phonics, Numbots activity, daily reading and a comprehension task, as well as a termly range of topic themed tasks. Uploaded topic learning will be shared each week in class.

Reading

Reading should be done daily at home. This ensures your child progresses brilliantly this year! Remember to sign the reading record book when reading with your child.
