Benefits of reading for 20 minutes at least 5 times a week*

1. Reading extends and improves vocabulary.
2. Reading makes all subjects easier to access (questions in maths, research in history, etc).

Science

Our Topic this half-term we are continuing with 'Uses of Everyday Materials'. We will be learning to Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials including: wood, metal, plastic, glass and rock for particular uses.

We will also be finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Topic

Our **History** topic this term will be **Significant people and nurturing nurses**. This is an exploration of people from different periods and we compare and sequence events.

Home Learning

CGP Books continue to be used, starting at workout 7 on both the Mathematics and Literacy. are now being used for home learning across. These will be sent home on a **Thursday** and must be returned to school the following **Monday**. Home Learning will be marked together in class.
