Dear Parents and Carers

Throughout our primary school learning journey, we spend time thinking about our physical and mental health and wellbeing. The children will take part in a carousel of activities during the visit (including a stadium tour and educational workshops) before finishing with a football tournament on the AstroTurf!

We will travel to the stadium on public transport and will be back at school for 3:30 pm

(Please note that this is slightly later than the usual end of day).

Your child will need to bring a **packed lunch** and a **water bottle**. It is sensible to keep an eye on the weather forecast that morning, to judge whether your child needs either a raincoat or a hat. All children are required to wear their normal school uniform, including school jumper/cardigan and school shoes (**no trainers**).

Children will require a packed lunch on the day as we will eat this at the museum during our visit.

There is no cost for this trip.

School trips also help children to develop the values of responsibility and independence as they learn to represent themselves outside of school.
