### At home

Please support your child to complete their **reading** at home each week. 5 signatures are expected each week, showing that your child has read for a period of **20 minutes**, **5 times** during that week. Developing reading pace and stamina is so important and can make all the difference in the classroom; reading is at the core of all learning.

We also expect children to complete a minimum of **30 minutes** on **TTRS each week** – this is best achieved by practising for **5 minutes each day**.

There are also weekly tasks set in the CGP Maths and English home learning books. These continue to be sent home every Thursday to be returned to by school the following Tuesday when they will be marked in class. Please encourage your child to ask if there is anything they are unsure about.

In addition to this, **spellings** will be posted on Google Classrooms **every Monday** to learn at home. There are weekly **tests at school** on **Fridays**.

In addition to this, there is a **Home Learning Project**. This has a geography link for Autumn 2 and has been set on the important topic of **sustainability**. Projects are due in on **Monday 11**<sup>th</sup> **December** – further information is available on Google Classroom. Prizes will be given for presentation, information and entertainment.
