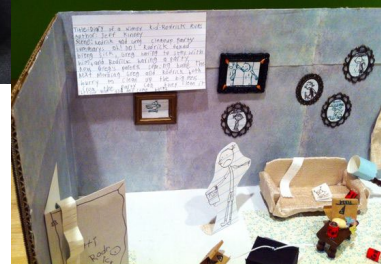


Topic: Book in a Box



Our home learning project this half term links to the wonderful **World Book Day**. It is a chance to get creative and celebrate your favourite stories. You will need to design and create a **Book in a Box**. This will need to be brought into school on (or before) **Monday 25th March 2024**.

You will need to recreate one of your favourite scenes from one of your favourite books ... inside a box! Any box will do: shoe box, amazon box, cereal box etc.

Think of a story with an iconic setting. For example, the dining hall at Hogwarts in *Harry Potter*, Charlie's grandparents' bed in *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, the wardrobe in *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* or the classroom in *The Boy at the Back of the Class*. Collect or make objects that fit with that setting. Decorate the inside of the box to represent the key moment within your chosen story.

Think about how you will decorate the outside of the box. Will that give a clue about the story, setting or scene inside?

Write a short paragraph about your Book in a Box, including why you chose the book and why this particular scene is important to you.
