Dear Parents and Carers,

Next term, Year 6 will be learning about Ancient Greece in our history and literacy lessons. To further develop our understanding and experience of this topic, we will be visiting **The British Museum** on **Friday 12**th **January 2024.** This will be a self-led visit around the museum and we will be taking part in an iPad Parthenon trail as well as activity trails focusing Ancient Greek Gods and Goddesses. It will be a wonderful launch to this history unit and hopefully lead the children towards a deeper understanding and appreciation of this period of history.

We will travel to the museum on public transport and will be back at school for the end of the school day at 3:10pm. Children will require a packed lunch on the day as we will eat this at the museum during our visit.

Your child will need to bring a **packed lunch** and **a water bottle**. It is sensible to keep an eye on the weather forecast that morning, to judge whether your child needs either a raincoat or a hat. All children are required to wear their normal school uniform, including school jumper/cardigan and school shoes (**no trainers**).

There is no cost for this trip.

Educational visits are a great opportunity for children to extend their learning beyond the classroom and apply skills they have learnt in school in a different context. School trips also help children to develop the values of responsibility and independence as they learn to represent themselves outside of school.
