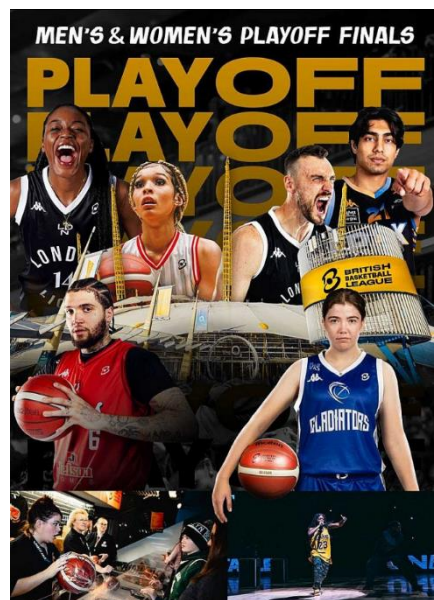
£10 Basketball Tickets
