We desperately need tissues in school. All children that donate a box of tissues for their class will receive a team point. Thank you

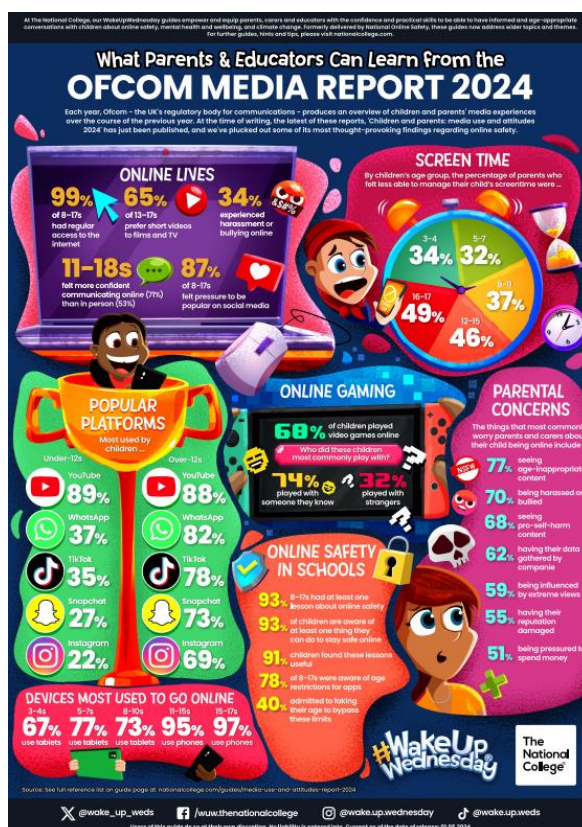
CHANGES TO PE UNIFORM
